Rev. John Daugherty

Pastor John and Phyllis left Maple Springs Baptist Church in the Fall of 2005 to become the Executive Coordinator for the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship of Louisiana and over-saw after-hurricane response in the area between Mandeville and Slidel on the north shore of Lake Ponchartraine. John was also very involved with the development of the rural poverty initiative, Together for Hope, in the northeastern delta region of the state.

In the winter of 2008 John was called to be the Senior Pastor with First Baptist Church, Fort Myers FL. While there First Baptist entered a covenant of shared ministry with a new church start in the area and shared the campus of FBC. In 2013 the congregations merged to form CityGate Ministries which continues to be a thriving and growing church reaching and ministering to the downtown area of Fort Myers.

July of 2015 John was invited to become the Associate Director of Operation Inasmuch, Inc. in Knoxville, TN and became the Executive Director in January 2016 following the retirement of the founding Executive Director. Operation Inasmuch is now working in 24 states and four nations with over 2200 participating churches and faith-based organizations. John traveled to Gaborone, Botswana in October of last year to conduct Inasmuch Day workshops and participate in Open Baptist Church's 4th Inasmuch Day. He just returned from a trip to Armenia where he introduced the Inasmuch model with the unions that make up the European Baptist Federation.

When we left Maple Springs we were expecting our 1st grandchild – now have six ages 11 down to 1!
